To all Teams and Competitors,

Mazda recently released updated information on oil specifications and oil pressure minimums for rotary racing engines. The Star Mazda Championship presented by Goodyear, effective May 10<sup>th</sup> 2010, has added rule D.4.j). Mazda recommends that participants use synthetic 20w-50 engine oil that should not exceed 235 degrees Fahrenheit during operation. Mazda has also stated that engines should run 10 psi per 1,000 RPM minimum oil pressure.

**Supplemental Rulebook Addition: Effective May 10<sup>th</sup> 2010**

**D.4.j) Viscosity of the engine oil must be no less than Grade SAE 30 at 210 degrees Fahrenheit.**
