You are strongly encouraged to read the style guide and rule book closely, in addition to the new forms as there are some changes from past practice.

With the change to INDYCAR sanctioning upcoming, IndyCar Director of Operations Bill Van De Sandt has been named Series Race Director.

Other changes of note include:

- It is not permitted to test on a Championship Series track, unless specifically authorized by the Series
- A point will be given for fastest race lap.

Note from Gary Rodrigues:

We will be sanctioned by INDYCAR. INDYCAR has appointed one of their officials to be our Race Director. That is Bill Van De Sandt, who is looking forward to the new responsibility. We have worked with him on many operational projects before, and have had universally positive results. We are looking forward to continuing that trend.
