2011 LICENSING AND CREDENTIAL GUIDELINES

DRIVER LICENSING

INDYCAR issues Star Mazda Championship presented by Goodyear licenses to qualified drivers age 16 and older.

Drivers under 18 years of age must contact the series office for minor driver license application forms.

For drivers 18 years of age or older, INDYCAR is processing licenses via their website, at:
<http://hardcards.indycar.com>. Begin by clicking on "New Driver". The website will walk you through the application procedure. Payment of \$650 must be made at the time the license application is submitted.

All drivers are required to obtain clearance from INDYCAR Medical Services before participating in any on-track activity. Contact Linda at 317-492-8785 or lstaletovich@brickyard.com

Each driver license includes an FIA license and one additional annual credential along with the driver STARMAZDA / INDYCAR license/credential. Once a driver application is submitted and payment received, the driver will be issued a code which can be redeemed for an annual credential at <http://hardcards.indycar.com>.

ANNUAL EVENT CREDENTIALS ("HARD CARDS")

To obtain annual credentials, a team must first register as an Entrant via the website <http://hardcards.indycar.com>. Begin by clicking on New Entrant. The website will walk you through the application procedure.

Once the application and payment (\$850) is received, the primary Entrant contact will receive an email with eight codes. These codes may be distributed to team members and redeemed for an annual credential via <http://hardcards.indycar.com>.

The main Entrant contact person may login at any time throughout the season to manage their annual credential list and may purchase additional annual credentials through the site as well. If a team member leaves the team, their annual credential can be turned in to INDYCAR and that member code is then freed up to be used by a new team member.

INDYCAR does not issue annual credentials to anyone under 18 years of age, with the exception of INDYCAR approved series drivers between the ages of 16 and 18.

COUPONS AND SINGLE EVENT CREDENTIALS

OVERVIEW

STAR MAZDA utilizes a coupon redemption system for single event credentials. STAR MAZDA prints and distributes coupons to its participants, and participants distribute these coupons to their guests. The guests arrive at the STAR MAZDA trackside credential office at each track during the scheduled registration hours, and receive STAR MAZDA pit/garage credentials in exchange for the coupons. All guests must sign the event coupon, a liability waiver and present photo identification at registration.

Coupons can only be redeemed during registration hours and are unable to be left at track Will Call locations as track personnel are not INDYCAR or STAR MAZDA officials.

DISTRIBUTION

STAR MAZDA will distribute coupons to participants approximately 14 days prior to an event. Each Entrant/Driver combination will receive eight coupons per event.

ADDITIONAL COUPONS

While participants may request additional coupons, STAR MAZDA does not guarantee such requests will be approved. Requests must be submitted no later than 10 days prior to the load in day of an event and be made in writing via email or fax to the series office.

AGE LIMIT

STAR MAZDA is only able to issue credentials to those individuals who are 18 years of age or older, with the exception of INDYCAR approved series drivers between the ages of 16 and 18.

PHOTOGRAPH IDENTIFICATION

Individuals redeeming coupons must provide a government-issued identification that includes name, date of birth and photograph. Examples include: Drivers License, Passport, or Military ID (Student ID will not be accepted). STAR MAZDA is unable to issue a credential to any individual without this identification.

MINOR CREDENTIALS

While STAR MAZDA is unable to issue credentials to minors, individuals with minors should contact event promoters to confirm the specific minor policy (some may provide limited access such as infield, hospitality, etc). In order to avoid any uncomfortable situation at the STAR MAZDA trackside credentials office, STAR MAZDA strongly encourages participants to inform their guests of this policy (especially during the summer months when school is not in session) and not distribute coupons to minors.

CREDENTIAL OFFICE HOURS

Prior to an event, individuals are encouraged to review the posted credential office hours on the series website. In addition, the hours will be posted at the STAR MAZDA trackside credentials office during the event and on the coupons themselves.

PARKING PASSES

Parking passes will be granted per team and per driver at each event, based on quantities allotted to the series by the event promoter.

SPECIALIZED PARKING

If an individual has a specialized parking request, (i.e. motor home, handicap, etc.), the individual must contact the event promoter in advance of the event.
