



## **Chuck Hulse and DFR win at Miller Motorsports Park**

Chuck Hulse of Yorba Linda, California finished right where he left off in 2008 capturing the Masters win in Round Three of the Star Mazda Championship presented by Goodyear at Miller Motorsports Park in Tooele, Utah.

The 2008 Masters Champ, driving the #12 DFR Silicon Salvage Pro Formula Mazda, had a hard fought, race long battle with Michael Guasch but came out on top in the end. At the completion of the 22 lap event, Hulse not only out paced all of the Masters competitors, but also all of the Expert class drivers.

Team manager Dave Freitas was happy about the Miller results. “I would like to thank Chuck for giving us the chance this season to run him in the Pro Mazda, as we had such a good time with him in the Pro Formula 2000 car last season. With Ian Lacy engineering the car and Rick Torres turning the wrenches, our team is pretty solid and I am confident that we can continue to make strong showings when we get the chance to run these Star Mazda Championship events.”

Chuck Hulse returns to the cockpit May 31 at Thunderhill Raceway with DFR with hopes of extending his Molecule Series win streak to 7.
