**ART. 12 - STARTING GRID**

12.3.1 - "**Pole position**" (place on track): Reserved for the car which has achieved the fastest lap time during qualifying sessions, is on the left of the front row according to circuit homologation by the FIA.

**ART. 18 - REPAIRS & MAINTENANCE**

18.10 - It is forbidden to pass through the pit lane without stopping at the pit, except in case of "stop and go" (Art. 5.11.a) or a car passing through the pit lane on its way to the competition paddock with permission from the Race Director.  
Whatever the reason is, when a car comes to a stop in the pits, **the engine must be switched off:**  
**Penalty: "Stop and go", engine switched off and turned on again by the driver.**

**ART. 21 - DRIVER CHANGES**

**21.2- Maximum Driving Time:**

- a. A Driver may not drive more than eight (8) hours total in the race.
- b. A Driver may not drive for more than four (4) hours in any six (6) hour period.
- c. Reserve drivers are not permitted.

**Penalty for any of the above:** Exclusion of car, Drivers and Entrant.

Note: Computation of the time requirement will be at the sole discretion of IMSA.

**ART. 27 - PRIZE MONEY & CUPS**

To be eligible to receive Race Prize Money the car must complete 70% of the distance completed by the overall race winner. In addition, to be eligible to receive Championship Points an Entrant must be enrolled in the Series Entrant Program.

Drivers and crew members must wear series required patches as designated in the IMSA Code. Drivers and crew members appearing at award ceremonies without required patches or with patches from competing series or sanctioning bodies may result in the Entrant forfeiting all prize money.

## APPENDICES

### III - MISCELLANEOUS:

**DRIVER CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS ELIGIBILITY:** To be eligible for point awards, each Driver must complete at least 25 laps and the car must complete at least 70% of the distance of the overall winning car.

Maximum driving time:

- Driver may not drive more than eight (8) hours total in the race.
- A Driver may not drive for more than four (4) hours in any six (6) hour period.
- Reserve drivers are not permitted.

**Penalty for any of the above:** Exclusion of car, drivers and entrant.

**Note:** Computation of the time requirement will be at the sole discretion of IMSA.

**CHANGE OF A DRIVER:** Changes regarding a nominated Driver are not permitted after administrative checking is closed (Tuesday, 13<sup>th</sup> March 2007 at 4:00 pm). A driver change after Registration is closed will only be permitted by the Race Director in case of force majeure and with permission of the Stewards'.

**QUALIFYING DRIVER:** The entrant must record the name of the Driver who achieved the Official "**fast lap**" during qualifying, on the Qualifying Driver form. The Qualifying Driver form must be given to a pit lane official **within 30 minutes** after the end of each qualifying session. The final Qualifying Driver form must also include the nominated Starting Driver. Any changes to the Starting Driver must be submitted in writing to the Race Director and if approved, the car must start the race from the pit lane.

**TIRES:** Per American Le Mans Series Standing Supplementary Regulations Attachment 3, marked tires will be required for all American Le Mans Series cars commencing with the first on-track session on Thursday, 15<sup>th</sup> March 2007 at 10:15 am. Maximum quantity of 24 dry tires for this event.

**TECHNICAL INSPECTIONS:** All cars for the American Le Mans Series must be presented for and pass technical inspection by Wednesday, 14<sup>th</sup> March at 10:00 am unless a written request for an extension has been approved by the Stewards. Timing transponders will be provided by IMSA.

**MANDATORY DRIVER AUTOGRAPH SESSION:** A mandatory driver autograph session for **ALL** American Le Mans Series drivers has been scheduled for Friday, 16<sup>th</sup> March beginning at 12:05 pm in the American Le Mans Series competitor paddock.

Paddock Restrictions: No pets, scooters, bicycles, motorcycles or firearms allowed.
