**ART. 27 - PRIZE MONEY & CUPS**

To be eligible to receive Race Prize Money the car must complete 70% of the distance completed by the overall race winner. In addition, to be eligible to receive Championship Points an Entrant must be enrolled in the Series Entrant Program.

Drivers and crew members must wear series required patches as designated in the IMSA Code. Drivers and crew members appearing at award ceremonies without required patches or with patches from competing series or sanctioning bodies may result in the Entrant forfeiting all prize money.

## APPENDICES

### III - MISCELLANEOUS:

**DRIVER CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS ELIGIBILITY:** To be eligible for point awards, each Driver must complete at least 25 laps and the car must complete at least 70% of the distance of the overall winning car.

Maximum driving time:

- Driver may not drive more than eight (8) hours total in the race.
- A Driver may not drive for more than four (4) hours in any six (6) hour period.
- Reserve drivers are not permitted.

**Penalty for any of the above:** Exclusion of car, drivers and entrant.

**Note:** Computation of the time requirement will be at the sole discretion of IMSA.

**CHANGE OF A DRIVER:** Changes regarding a nominated Driver are not permitted after administrative checking is closed (Tuesday, 11<sup>th</sup> March 2008 at 4:00 pm). A driver change after Registration is closed will only be permitted by the Race Director in case of force majeure and with permission of the Stewards'.

**QUALIFYING DRIVER:** The entrant must record the name of the Driver who achieved the Official "**fast lap**" during qualifying, on the Qualifying Driver form. The Qualifying Driver form must be given to a pit lane official **within 30 minutes** after the end of each qualifying session. The final Qualifying Driver form must also include the nominated Starting Driver. Any changes to the Starting Driver must be submitted in writing to the Race Director and if approved, the car must start the race from the pit lane.

**TIRES:** Per American Le Mans Series Standing Supplementary Regulations Attachment 3, marked tires will be required for all American Le Mans Series cars commencing with the first on-track session on Thursday, 13<sup>th</sup> March 2008 at 10:15 am. Maximum quantity of 24 dry tires for this event.

**TECHNICAL INSPECTIONS:** All cars for the American Le Mans Series must be presented for and pass technical inspection by Wednesday, 12<sup>th</sup> March at 9:30 am unless a written request for an extension has been approved by the Stewards.

**MANDATORY DRIVER AUTOGRAPH SESSION:** A mandatory driver autograph session for **ALL** American Le Mans Series drivers has been scheduled for Friday, 14<sup>th</sup> March beginning at 12:05 pm in the American Le Mans Series competitor paddock.

Paddock Restrictions: No pets, scooters, bicycles, motorcycles or firearms allowed. Due to safety considerations, the use of pit carts, 3 and 4 wheel ATV's are restricted as follows: Pit Carts and ATV's may only be used to carry parts and equipment to and from the pits. They are not to be used for personal transportation and may not be taken out of the paddock. All vehicles in the pits and paddock must be operated in a safe manner. These areas are very crowded and reckless driving will not be tolerated. All pit vehicles must have front and rear lighting operational during periods of darkness.

ATV team stickers are **MANDATORY** and will be issued at registration. **ALL OPERATORS MUST HAVE A DRIVER'S LICENSE.**

Team golf carts will be allowed to/from registration and shipping/receiving only. No team golf carts will be allowed in general admission areas including the midway. **THIS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED. Deliveries of golf carts by non approved Sebring International Raceway vendors WILL NOT BE ALLOWED on property.**

Television Rentals: Television rentals will be available to teams at a cost of \$250 per 27" television, other sizes are also available. Additional cable run to remote areas (if available) at a cost of \$150. Teams interested in renting a television or for cabling should **contact Travis O'Bannon at (863) 655-1442, ext. 208.**

Hours of operation on Monday thru Wednesday will be 8:00 am - 5:00 pm.
